My partner and I created a computer generated program, made it easier to control,keep track of all detailed information on every crane.When we were evaluated by the inspectors from Washington on a yearly basis,saw the program we made, liked it and took the program and utilized it throughout the Navy to make it easier and safer to keep track of all information on cranes, before that all we had was a paper trail.

Here is where I was able to use my experience and understanding of crane accidents because every time I had to go out to repair whatever it was needed you have to realize everything here is over 80-100 years old.
